Section 59-112-70 of the SC Code of Laws authorizes the Boards of Trustees of the public institutions to provide fee waivers for students participating in international Sister-State agreement programs. The Commission on Higher Education, through coordination with the Department of Commerce, is required to notify institutions annually of the current Sister-State agreements that are eligible for the non-resident fee waiver.
